

PRIVACY POLICY

Our Privacy Policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect and use the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our Web site and our products and services.

Information Collected.

When you visit our Web site, you may provide us with two types of information: personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis and Web site use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse our Web site.

Personal Information You Choose to Provide. P3000 Corporation (“P3000”) collects personally identifiable information when you become a registered user, by asking you to fill out an online registration form. It is necessary to become a registered user to order products and services online and to personalize your Web site visits. In order to properly provide the different services ordered, P3000 needs to collect and store personally identifiable information such as: name, address, birth date, passport number (Visa Systems), citizenship, phone number, e-mail address, emergency contact, medical and health history, credit card information (for online ordering and billing only), the school you are attending while overseas (applicable for students), the period of time you will spend abroad, and other related items. We may contact you via e-mail, telephone or fax to collect additional important information as well. If you choose to correspond with us through e-mail, we may retain the content of your e-mail messages together with your e-mail address and our responses.

Web Site Use Information. Similar to other commercial Web sites, our Web site utilizes a standard technology called "cookies" and Web server logs to collect information about how our Web site is used. A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a Web site, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each Web site can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a Web site to access the cookies it has already sent to you, not the cookies sent to you by other sites. Information gathered through cookies and Web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our Web site, and the Web sites visited just before and just after our Web site. We, our advertisers, and ad serving companies may also use small pieces of code called “Web beacons” or “clear gifs” to determine which advertisements and promotions users have seen and how users responded to them.

Other. It is not necessary to provide any personally identifiable information to access any part of the public section of our Web site, such as the online shopping area. P3000 does not knowingly collect information from any person under the age of 13 and does not target children under age 13.

How Information is Used.

Personally identifiable information is collected and used only by P3000, for the following purposes: to fulfill your order requests for products and services; to customize the content of “My Platform” and your accounts; to contact you about important information and updates; for billing and order processing purposes; fulfillment and maintenance of membership and service agreements.

As you shop on our Web site, the site uses its cookies to differentiate you from other shoppers so your shopping cart is only available to you. In some cases, we also use cookies to prevent you from seeing unnecessary advertisements or requiring you to log in more than is necessary for security. Cookies, in conjunction with our Web server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our Web site and which parts of the site are most popular. This helps us gather feedback in order to constantly improve our Web site and better serve our customers. Cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not generally store any personal information that you provided to us in your cookies.

Information Sharing. We will not sell, trade, publish or rent your personal information to others, and will not share personal information outside of the required individuals to process the application and the service. In certain circumstances, P3000 shares your personally identifiable information in the following situations only: we have your consent to share the information; we need to provide the information to your parents, school or consulate; we are legally required to provide information to third parties in response to court orders, subpoenas or legal process; we find that your actions violate the law or our User Agreement; we need to protect and defend our rights and property, the Web site, or the users of the Web site; or we feel that an emergency situation has arisen that requires us to release information before we can contact you for consent (such as a verified family emergency). From time to time, we may partner or enter into arrangements with another party to provide specific benefits and services to our clientele. If you sign up for said benefits and/or services, we will provide to said third party the information we believe is reasonably necessary for them to provide such benefits and/or services to you. If you do not wish to receive marketing communications from our partners or us, you may express your preference to not be contacted by sending an e-mail or letter at the contact below informing us of your preference.

Protection of Information. All collected documents and data are stored in P3000's secure database to protect your personal information provided to us. P3000 can only guarantee the security of these documents while in the possession of P3000. Failure to follow P3000's order of instructions may result in the delay or rejection of applications. To help protect the privacy of data and personally identifiable information you transmit through use of our Web site, we maintain physical, technical and administrative safeguards. We update and test our security technology on a regular basis. We restrict access to your personally identifiable information to those employees who need the information to provide benefits and services to you. In addition, we train our employees about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the privacy and security of your information.
